State Republican Executive Committee (SREC) Update

A few updates from Jeneria Lewis, our SREC Senate District 27 Committeewoman:

- The Speaker of the Texas House of Representatives, Dustin Burrows, pushed through a change of rules that negatively impacted the strength of the Republican majority
- The Legislative Priorities committee of the SREC met on January 30th and reviewed the filed Senate and House bills. The committee selected which bills to endorse and to reject for the Republican Party of Texas
- The Republican Party of Texas is receiving many inquiries regarding censuring elected officials who violate the Republican caucus rules
