While this process may seem daunting, most (if not all candidates) will provide some sort of contact information which one can utilize to reach out and ask questions. I implore you to do just that-reach out to candidates. We must make every effort to elect people that best reflect our values.

In his book, “Letter to the American Church”, Eric Metaxas makes a profound claim when he writes, “Just as cowardice begets cowardice, courage begets courage. When we speak out, we inevitably encourage others to speak out along with us, decreasing the price of speaking out. So there is no way to remain neutral in situations.
